1. What Information Does Creative Productions Collect On The Site?

Cookies: Creative Productions utilizes cookie technology to gather information on internet use in order to serve you more effectively. You can set your browser to remove or reject cookies; however some Site features or Services may not work properly without cookies.

2. Is Information Collected By Or Disclosed To Third Parties By Using The Site?

Other Potential Third Party Disclosures: Information may also be disclosed to third parties (1) as required by law, such as to comply with a subpoena, or similar legal process, (2) when we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights, protect your safety or the safety of others, investigate fraud, or respond to a government request, or (3) if Creative Productions is involved in a merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a portion of its assets.

We will use commercially reasonable efforts to notify users (i) about law enforcement or court ordered requests for data unless otherwise prohibited by law, or (ii) if your personal information is to be disclosed or transferred and/or becomes subject to a different privacy policy.

3. How Is Collected Information Used And Stored?

Information collected may be utilized to (i) communicate with our users to respond to their inquiries, (ii) communicate to subscribers regarding important events or useful resources, (iii) to communicate material changes to our Privacy Policy; and/or (iv) help us maintain and improve services offered.

6. What Is Creative Productions’ Security Policy?

We have implemented reasonable administrative, technical and physical security measures to protect your personal information against unauthorized access, destruction or alteration. 7. How Does Creative Productions Respond To “Do Not Track” Signals?

“Do Not Track” is a feature enabled on some browsers that sends a signal to request that a web application disable its tracking or cross-site user tracking. At present, Creative Productions does not respond to or alter its practices when a Do Not Track signal is received.
